- CALL TO ORDER: The Board of Education of Unified School District No. 422, State of Kansas, Kiowa County, met for a regular meeting at the Sun Chips Incubator meeting room, 101 S. Main Street in Greensburg. The meeting was called to order by President Ki Gamble at 8:01 p.m.
