TITLE: Parent Educator for Parents as Teachers

REPORTS TO: Kim Mauk, CEO and Maria Ortiz-Smith, Coordinator

OBJECTIVE: To administer Parents as Teachers (PAT) program Parent Educator services including monthly or bi-monthly home visits, and planning and executing monthly family engagement activities. Perform daily operational functions through interaction with families and the community; collaboration with administration, and superintendents of contracting school districts; and Southwest Plains Regional Service Center's PAT coordinator. Foster the district focus of preparing students to be ready for college and careers.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Punctual, regular, and predictive attendance in accordance with family and district schedules:
- 2. Deal with confidential information and/or issues, using discretion and good judgment;
- 3. Initiate and/or administer the PAT Parent Educator responsibilities following national and state PAT requirements and guidelines;
- 4. Complete required trainings;
- 5. Advocate for the PAT program and families;
- 6. Promote and support the philosophy and mission of Parents as Teachers National Ctr.;
- 7. Manage a home office with internet access;
- 8. Communicate regularly with PAT coordinator;
- 9. Promote and support the mission and vision of the local school district;
- 10. Support the philosophy and mission of Parents as Teachers;
- 11. Comply with school board policy in the provision of duties; and
- 12. Perform other duties as assigned.

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ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Ability to lift 5-8 pounds;
- 2. Ability to sit on and get up and down off of the floor for periods of a time; and
- 3. Occasional stooping, bending, lifting, and reaching.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- 1. Demonstrated ability to work with adults and their young children;
- 2. Ability to travel to home visits, meetings, group connections;
- 3. Ability to be contacted by phone during working hours;
- 4. Ability to work and travel outside of normal business hours;
- 5. Independent problem solving ability;
- 6. Strong communication and interpersonal skills; and
- 7. Ability to follow verbal and written instructions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Valid driver's license;
- 2. High School Diploma and two years of supervised experience in working with children;
- 3. Knowledge of technology and ability to apply knowledge to assigned areas of responsibilities.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Required to work in a variety of settings and must be willing to adjust work strategies to accommodate limitations.
