







Week 1: June 3 - 6 Days: Monday - Thursday Times: 9:00 AM - Noon Location: Room 166, KCJH	<p>Programming / Coding. Students learn about coding using SCRATCH and other software. Students create code that drives an action or sound. What we learn here may be applied during week 2, and week 3.</p> 
Week 2: June 10 - 13 Days: Monday - Thursday Times: 9:00 AM - Noon Location: Room 166, KCJH, gym and other areas on campus	<p>Robotics. Students will use robot kits and coding software to build + operate robotic devices.</p> 
Week 3: June 17 - 21 Days: Monday - Friday Times: 9:00 AM - Noon Location: Room 166, KCJH, gym and other areas on campus	<p>Drones. Much like robotics, students apply what they've learned to give drones specific instructions and flight paths.</p>
